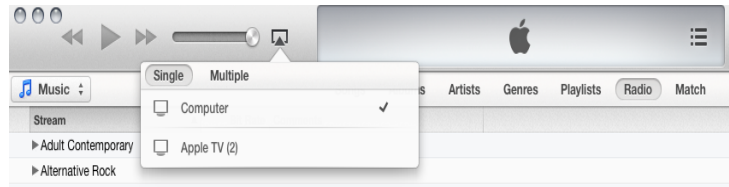


# **How To Connect Apple TV to your computer**

## **With machine earlier than 2011**

1. Update your iTunes on your computer so that it is at least iTunes version 10.5 or later
2. Plug in your Apple TV, and connect the HDMI cable into the back of the Apple TV and into your TV
3. Change the input of your TV to the one that has Apple TV connected. i.e. HDMI 1, or HDMI 2
4. Configure your internet connections onto the Apple TV
5. On your computer, locate the AirPlay icon in your iTunes application, or enable home sharing
  - a. If you do not see the AirPlay icon make sure that your computer is connected to the same wireless network that your Apple TV is connected to
6. You will then be able to play photos, music, and movies on your Apple TV



## **With machine later than 2011**

1. Connect your Apple TV to your Television
2. Make sure that the machine you are using is from 2011 or later, and is running Mountain Lion, OS 10.8
3. On the top menu bar of your machine on the right hand side you should see the AirPlay icon, click on that and the drop down bar appears, from there you select Apple TV as the device you are trying to connect to.
  - a. If the AirPlay icon doesn't appear or your Apple TV does not show up in the menu bar, make sure that you are connected to the same wireless network as your Apple TV
4. Your display will now be mirrored onto your Television through your Apple TV and you can play all the photos, music, and videos that you have on your computer onto your Television
