

How To enable iCloud

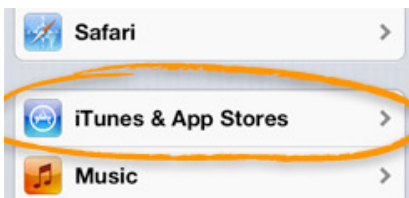
For your iPhone, iPad, or iPod



- Check to make sure your device is running the latest version of IOS
- Go to settings menu, General → software update. To see if there is an update available
- After the update follow the instructions in setup assistant to activate your device
- Or tap settings on the home screen and select iCloud then enter you

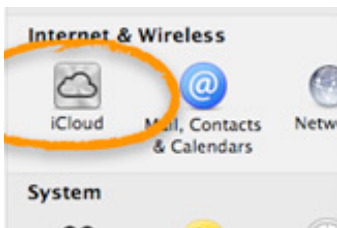
apple ID

- Tap settings → iCloud, then you will be able to turn on specific features of iCloud



- In your iTunes & App store tab within settings you can configure your music, apps, and books purchases to automatically be downloaded to all your devices

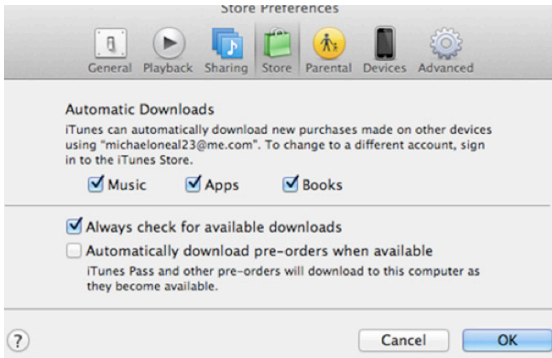
For your Mac



- Make sure your Mac is running OS X 10.7.4 or later
- The latest version of OS X is available at the app store
- Go to system preferences click iCloud
- You will be prompted to enter your apple ID
- After you have entered your apple ID you will be able to select the features that you would like shared throughout all your iCloud enabled devices



- For photo stream open iPhoto or Aperture and click the photo stream icon located in the left column of the application and click turn on photo stream



- For automatic downloads go to iTunes → Preferences → Store. Then select what items you want to be automatically download,
