

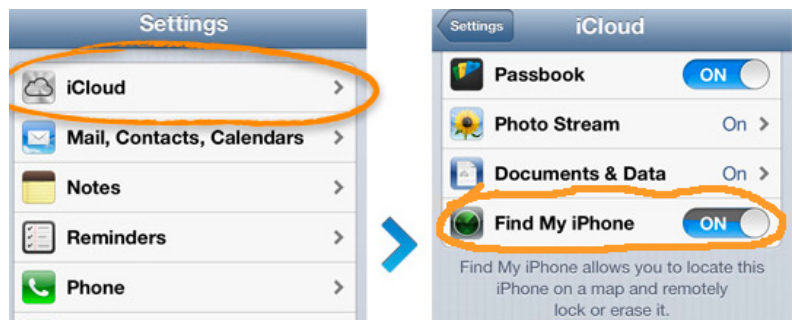
How to Configure Find My iPhone

Find my iPhone requires IOS 5 or later, or OSX 10.7.5 or later.

All Devices must be set up with the same iCloud account for them to show up for different devices.

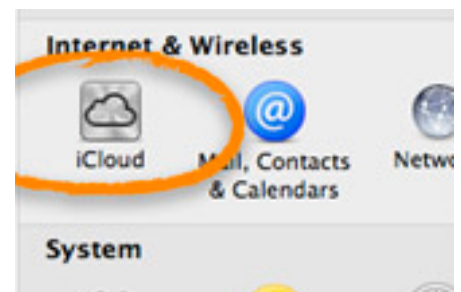
For iPhone

- On your device go to the Home Screen → Settings → iCloud
- Enter your Apple ID when prompted, if you do not have an Apple ID you can make one, by clicking the “Create an Apple ID” and follow the instructions that it gives your.
- Tap to turn on the “Find My iPhone” feature
- Then tap allow after a prompt appears
- You can add a password, and you can restrict the ability to disable the “Find My iPhone” feature so it can only be turned off by you.



For Mac

- Go to Apple Menu → System Preference → iCloud
- Enter your Apple ID when prompted, if you do not have an Apple ID you can make one by clicking the “Create Apple ID” then following the instructions



- Click “Find my Mac” checkbox to enable it, and then confirm you want to allow “Find My iPhone” to use the location of your Mac
