



How to Backup your iPhone, iPod, or iPad

IOS devices back up your purchased music, TV shows, Apps, Books. As well as your Photos and Videos in your camera roll, Device settings (Phone favourites, wallpaper, and Mail, Contacts, Calendar accounts) App data, Home screen and App organization, Messages (iMessage, SMS, and MMS) ringtones. Media files you have synced from your computer to your device will not be backed up, but can be restored by syncing with iTunes.

Backing up with iCloud

- Requires IOS 5 or later
- To enable backups go to settings → iCloud → Storage & Backup
- It will run on a daily basis if the following conditions are met:
 - Your device is connected to the internet over Wi-Fi
 - Your device is connected to a power source
 - Your Screen is locked
- Or if it is connected to Wi-Fi and you chose Back up now from Settings → iCloud → Storage & Backup



Restore from a Backup



-When using setup assistant on a new device using IOS 5 or later, chose “Restore from iCloud Backup”

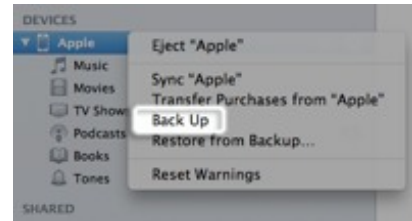
-Enter your iCloud account and Password you will see the three most recent Backups for each of the devices you enabled backups for and from there you can chose a backup to restore from

-If you wish to restore from iCloud backup erase your device by going to Settings → General → Reset → Erase all content and settings

- Select set up a new or restore from previous backups, Select restore from iCloud Backup. Enter your Apple ID and password when prompted.
- After device restarts all your backed up content will be downloaded to your machine
- To check progress go to Settings → iCloud → Storage & Backup

How to Backup with iTunes

- iTunes creates backups when:
 - Sync with iTunes(disabled if iCloud backup is turned on)
 - Right-click(command click) the IOS device under devices and chose Back-up



- Manually updating with iTunes
 - Connect your IOS device to a computer with the latest version of iTunes installed
 - Click the file menu and select Devices → Backup
- Or you can backup by:
 - Connect IOS device to a computer with the latest version of iTunes installed

Open IOS summary tab



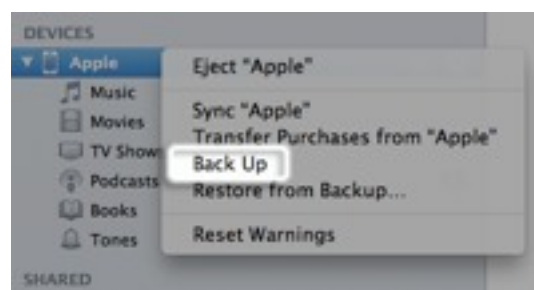
○Click view and select show sidebar select your iTunes under devices

-Or Click device button in upper right corner(if in iTunes store click Library button in upper right corner then your device will be visible

-Click back up now button

-To verify that Backup completed by going to iTunes Preferences → Devices, the name of the device will appear along with the date & time it was created

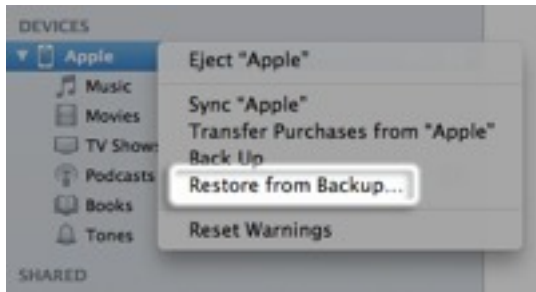
With iTunes 10.7 or earlier



- Right click(Command click) device located on left column
- Select back up as from the drop down menu

Restoring With iTunes

- Connect IOS device to computer
- Click file select devices→ restore from Backup
- Access device summary tab click restore backup
