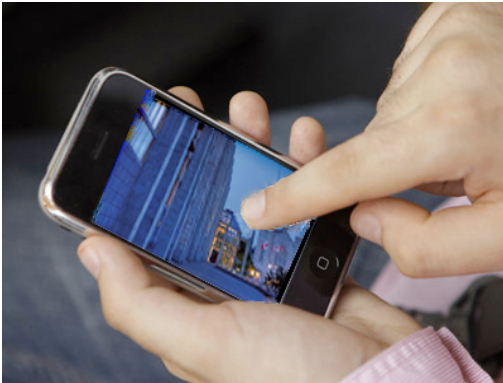


How To Print Wirelessly with IOS Devices



AirPrint is a built in program that works with your iPad's, iPhone (3GS or later), or iPod touch (3rd generation or later), running the latest version of IOS.

Most Wi-fi printers will support AirPrint but if your are not sure, here is a link to a list of all the AirPrint supported printers.

The list is organized based on the brand of your printer (cannon, HP, etc) and by the model number of your printer, which you can find on your printer

AirPrint is built into all of the Apple Apps, such as Safari, Mail, Photos, Pages, Number. etc and looks like:



- Some third party developers will also support AirPrint. Depending on the App that you are using the icon may not always look like the one above but it will for all Apple apps.

How To Print using AirPrint with your iPad, iPhone or iPod touch

- Select the item you want to print then tap the appropriate icon that gives you options for printing.

- Select your printer from the list that appears then tap print
- If you would like to print from an application that does not support AirPrint here is a nice trick:
 - Highlight the text or item that you wish to print, and copy it
 - Open notepad, or pages or some other App that supports AirPrint
 - Paste what you just copied into the new App.
 - Print your text, or item from the new App, the way that is mentioned above
- If you are unable to see your printer from the list make sure your printer and your IOS device are connected to the same wireless network
- You may have to turn on AirPrint on your printer for your printer to work
- If you are still having problems try:
 - Restarting the
 - Printing wirelessly from your Mac to see if it that works
 - Make sure the firmware on your printer is up to date, refer to your printer documentation on how to update the firmware.
